## **PSL POLICY AND PLANNING DIRECTOR ADDRESSES ST. JOHN PARISH COMMUNITY ADVISORY PANEL**

Lester Millet III, the Port of South Louisiana’s Policy and Planning Director, was recently guest speaker at the St. John Parish Community Advisory Panel’s May 10<sup>th</sup> meeting at the Garyville Magnet School. Comprised of local industry (Marathon, Nalco, Stockhausen, and Air Products) and concerned citizens, the Community Advisory Panel meets regularly to dialogue with plant officials and address issues of mutual interest.

Some key issues Millet touched upon during his presentation, included: The Port of South Louisiana’s location and statistics, Regional Layered Port Security, The Port of South Louisiana’s Facility Security Officers Working Group, TWIC, and the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the local Sheriff’s Departments. Following the brief presentation, a short video on the Port of South Louisiana was shown to the audience. Millet ended the presentation with a short question and answer session. The meeting was well attended and included the plant managers of both Marathon and Nalco.
