

# Second Quarter 2005 Tonnage Report

The comparison of exported, imported, domestic transshipment tonnage statistics during the second quarter of 2005 versus 2004 and from the period between July through June of the years 2004-2005 versus 2003-2004 yielded the following observations.

#### 1. TOTAL TONNAGE

#### 1.1 Second Quarters:

There was a 4% decrease of throughput tonnage in 2005 (56,425,350 short tons) as compared to 2004 (58,567,008 short tons), a difference of approximately 2.1 million short tons.

Out of the top four commodities handled within the Port of South Louisiana, three showed a decrease in 2005 when compared to 2004, while the other decreased:

#### 1.2 July - June (year comparison):

There was a 2% increase of throughput tonnage in '04-'05 (248,570,378 short tons) as compared to '03-'04 (243,198,271 short tons), a difference of approximately 5.4 million short tons.

Of the top four handled commodities, Crude Oil, Petrochemicals, and Soybean showed an increase in '04-'05 when compared to '03-'04, whereas Maize showed a decrease:

#### 2. EXPORTS

#### 2.1 Second Quarters:

Overall handling of exports increased in 2005 (9,838,358 short tons) as compared to 2004 (9,083,111 short tons) by 8% or approximately 755 thousand short tons. Out of the top four exports, two showed an increase in handling, while the other decreased:

#### 2.2 July - June (year comparison):

Overall handling of exports did not show a significant difference in '04-'05 (52,152,082 short tons) as compared to '03-'04 (52,353,770 short tons), but it was down by 201 thousand short tons. Out of the top four exports, Soybean showed an increase in handling, but Animal Feed, Maize, and Wheat did not:

### 3. IMPORTS

#### 3.1 Second Quarters:

Overall, 2005 imports (17,665,449) decreased by 13%, a decrease of 2.6 million tons from 2004 figures (20,269,782 short tons). Similarly, the handling of one of the top four imported commodities decreased:

#### 3.2 July - June (year comparison):

Overall, '04-'05 imports (68,879,778 short tons) increased by 4%, an increase of 2.9 million short tons from '03-'04 figures (65,955,245 short tons). Similarly, the handling of two of the top four imported commodities increased:

### 4. DOMESTIC SHIPMENTS

#### 4.1 Second Quarters:

Domestic shipments increased by 5% (597 thousand short tons) during 2005 (13,444,832 short tons) as compared to 2004 (12,848,138 short tons). In conjunction, two of the top four domestically shipped commodities increased in handling from last year:

Chemicals/Fertilizers	39%	<sup>1</sup> Up to 2.9 million short tons
Petrochemicals	4%	<sup>†</sup> Up to 6.1 million short tons
Coal/Lignite/Coke	63%	↓Down to 384 thousand short tons
Crude Oil	6%	Down to 1.9 million short tons

#### 4.2 July - June (year comparison):

Domestic shipments increased by 11% (5.5 million short tons) during '04-'05 (53,735,738 short tons) as compared to '03-'04 (48,223,292 short tons). In conjunction, the top four domestically shipped commodities increased in handling:

Chemicals/Fertilizers	4%	<sup>‡</sup> Up to 10.6 million short tons
Coal/Lignite/Coke	10%	<sup>†</sup> Up to 2.1 million short tons

Crude Oil	No significant difference	<sup>1</sup> Up to 48.9 million short tons

### 5. DOMESTIC RECEIPTS:

#### 5.1 Second Quarters:

Domestic receipts were down by 5% or over 889 thousand short tons in 2005 (15,476,710 short tons) when compared to 2004 (16,365,977 short tons). Similarly, two of the top four commodities showed such a decrease:

Maize	13%	↓Down to 5.5 million short tons
Petrochemicals	17%	↓Down to 3.6 million short tons
Animal Feed	8%	<sup>†</sup> Up to 983 thousand short tons
Soybean	90%	<sup>†</sup> Up to 2.4 million short tons

### 5.2 July - June (year comparison):


Year-to-date domestic receipts decreased by 4% or almost 2.9 million short tons in '04-'05 (73,802,780 short tons) when compared to '03-'04 (76,665,964 short tons). Similarly, two of the top four commodities showed such a decrease:

Animal Feed	10%	Down to 4.2 million short tons
Maize	7%	Down to 24 million short tons
Petrochemicals	1%	<sup>†</sup> Up to 14.9 million short tons
Soybean	25%	<sup>†</sup> Up to 17.5 million short tons
