Today I am wearing one of my Father's Day gifts, Dr. Strange cufflinks from my kids; they know I like the Marvel universe, so even though it's a little late, Happy Father's Day to all of you out there.

Thank you, Mr. Chairman for acknowledging one of our staff members, Charles Palmer, Jr, who lost his father recently, Mr. Charles Palmer, Sr. Charles' Birthday is in July so when it hits, and you see him tell Charles Happy Birthday-cheer him up a bit...give him some encouragement. Thank you again for putting that on the agenda.

We were very successful at the Legislature. I want to recognize Roy Quezaire and also Chris Coulon (who couldn't make it today). Roy worked very hard at the Capitol. Roy was there every single day. I knew he was there because people kept telling me he was there when I went to the Capitol. Bottomline, upfront the Port of South Louisiana was successful in accomplishing all of our goals at the session this year. We were able to move funds further into Priority 2, or Priority 1, that was requested- whether it was the drainage funding or movement of the \$487 thousand from SOLAPORT (St. Charles) to our road projects at Globalplex. We were also able to maintain all of the funding from the Second Dock Access Bridge in Priority 1 and through the new LED Infrastructure Fund there is a dedicated \$15 million dollars for particularly the Hyundai project for planning, permitting and design. There are a few processes we will have to do working with LED. There was great coordination between the Port and LED in this matter.

Outside of that we were aware of the Bills supported by PAL that helped other Ports including the Port of Caddo Bossier-Shreveport and the Ports of northeastern Louisiana as they try to build public/private railroad shortlines which could have an opportunity to move more cargo between that Port domestically and the Port of South Louisiana, domestically. All and all it was a great session.

Mr. Quezaire is here, /Roy/ if you want to add anything you are more than welcome to.

Roy Quezaire gave comments about the Legislative Session.

Other items we participated in: last Friday, was the Louisiana International Trade Conference to discuss the opportunities and challenges on the Lower Mississippi River. We had all five(5) ports on the lower Mississippi River on the panel with Commissioner Julia Fisher Cormier as the moderator for the event.

The Chairman and I along with Marc Hebert, the Chairman of Louisiana Ports and Waterways Investment Commission, traveled to Washington, D.C. to meet with Oman Ambassador-Tala Al Rahbi, who incidentally graduated from the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and his in-laws are in Opelousas. He travels to Louisiana often. We talked about having some good food when he is back in town. Bottomline, the Meeting was about opportunities for the Port -best practices. I think there is an opportunity for us to work with them (Oman), exporting a significant amount of grain to not just Oman but the other six (6) ports in the consortium, Persian Gulf Logistic Coalition.

Mr. Cormier has been doing a lot. He is graduate of the New Orleans Leadership Institute. Cake, cap and gown in the back.

He has been calling on potential customers in the Northeast being very efficient in finding direct investments at our port.

We had the report of the first quarter tonnage numbers and some of the Commissioners had questions about those numbers as it relates to revenue. When you look at the numbers we actually had growth compared to the first quarter 2024 -exports/ imports; however the total difference was actually on domestic shipments received. However, that does not play a significant part in our tariffs as our tariff revenue comes from what is coming over the docks but not necessarily just domestic shipments from sea. So we actually increased the revenue in the first quarter of 2025 as compared to 2024, even though the tonnage numbers were flipped. That kind of gives you a better explanation for that.

Also, I am very proud to announce this: according to the United States Foreign Trade Zone Board, the Port of South Louisiana is now the number one Foreign Trade Zone in the United States. We plan on shouting that to the rooftop. Every college wants to be number one; like LSU with baseball we are number one. We are number one when it comes to foreign trade zone, merchandise received and value and that is why companies like Hyundai want to work with us because they see the opportunities in economic development and reducing their risk, cost and increases their efficiency to move cargo and advance manufacturing, so we are very proud of that.
